DAY LICENCE

- To encourage the entry of **FORMER** drivers back to the sport.
- Are valid only for competition at individual events.
- A driver can obtain only two (2) DAY Licences in one season.
- Not valid for any Championship, Major Day or, Speed/Time Trials.
- Require the use of the Self-Assessing DAY MEDICAL Form.
- Can be upgraded to FULL or ½ YEAR Licences

NOVICE LICENCE

- To encourage the entry of **NEW** drivers.
- Are valid for competition at individual events.
- Only two (2) NOVICE Licences can EVER be obtained.
- Not valid for any Championship, Major Day or Speed/Time Trials.
- Require the use of the Self-Assessing NOVICE MEDICAL Form.
- Are not to be issued to any driver that has previously held any type of APBA Competition Licence.
- Can be upgraded to FULL or ½ YEAR Licences

SINGLE EVENT LICENCES

- An applicant must have held a FULL Licence in the previous year and show proof of it.
- Are valid for the duration of a single sanctioned meeting.
- Requires the holder to obtain a current Medical Certificate.
- Cannot be upgraded during the season - only additional Single Event Licences may be purchased.

BRIDGE LICENCE

- Available for the Bridge-to-Bridge Powerboat Race ONLY.

PLEASE NOTE: MEDICAL EXAMINATIONS ARE REQUIRED EVERY YEAR. As with your APBA Licence, the medical expires on 31 August each year, regardless of when you had it done. DO NOT THROW YOUR CURRENT RULE BOOK AWAY. There will be no new Rule Books printed this year.

THERE WILL BE A NEW LICENCE BOOK ISSUED FOR 2007-08. This will contain your Licence, National Race Calendar, Contact information and Rules Changed over the past 12 months.

EMAIL ADDRESS - IF YOU HAVE AN EMAIL ADDRESS, PLEASE COMPLETE THE SECTION OF YOUR LICENCE and/or BOAT OWNER APPLICATION – in this electronic age, the NSW Council and Clubs can send information to you faster and direct via email.

RENEWAL CHECKLIST

- MEDICAL EXAMINATION (FORM 22) OR JUNIOR MEDICAL (FORM 22J)
 - Regardless if you had a Medical last year, you will need a NEW Medical for this season.
 - The Junior Self-Assessing Medical must be filled in and signed off by a parent or guardian.
- LICENCE FORM (FORM 23 CL) – this form needs to be fully filled out. You must also have your Club Sign off that you are a current member. You will also need to include the following:
 - A photocopy of your NSW Maritime or other State Boating Authority Boating Licence
 - Signatures or other documentation proving that you have raced on 3 occasions during 2006-07.Failure to provide documentation will result in a Provisional Licence being issued.
 - Proof of Cockpit Immersion Testing.
- BOAT OWNER FORM (FORM 23 BO) – this contains ALL information pertaining to your boat (or boats) and MUST be completed by YOU AND YOUR CLUB as proof of your current membership. Please include:
 - A photocopy of your NSW Maritime or other State Boating Authority registration.
- ALL APPLICATIONS MUST INCLUDE PAYMENT: CHEQUES or MONEY ORDERS are to be made out in favour of Australian Power Boat Association.
- if posting you Application, please allow 10 working days for processing.

YOUR APPLICATION WILL NOT BE PROCESSED AND RETURNED IF:

- A photocopy of your NSW Maritime or other State Boating Authority Boat Licence and/or Boat Registration is not attached.
- Forms (*Medical/Licence/Boat Owner*) are NOT COMPLETE or NOT SIGNED by YOURSELF or YOUR CLUB – it is YOUR responsibility to prove you have current Club Membership – not mine!
- No Proof that you competed on at least 3 occasions during 2006-07. If there is no proof, you will be issued with a PROVISIONAL LICENCE – meaning that you will not be eligible to compete at the UHPBC Spectacular. Again, it is your responsibility to get your three Licence signatures – not mine!
- There is NO Payment is attached.
